Background information: The Governor's proclamation dated August 28, 2017, regarding Hurricane Harvey states "[p]ursuant to Section 418.016 of the [Texas Government Code], any regulatory statute prescribing the procedures for conduct of state business or any order or rule of a state agency that would in any way prevent, hinder or delay necessary action in coping with this disaster shall be suspended upon written approval of the Office of the Governor." This emergency rulemaking meeting is to provide temporary Texas licenses to professional engineers from other states to assist in rebuilding the areas of Texas affected by Hurricane Harvey.
