Highlights:

- HB2649 was passed during the recent legislative session with changes to the engineering practice act. You can read the entire bill [here](#) . One change prohibits requirements for additional certifications for license holders. The Board has released a statement concerning this issue which you can read [here](#).
- Reminder: The Board has passed rules that require all engineering documents released, issued, or submitted by or for a registered engineering firm, including preliminary documents, clearly indicate the engineering firm name and registration number. It is both the responsibility of the PE that signs and seals a document and the firm that releases the document to verify that the firm name and number appear on the engineering work. - April 2009 exam grades are in and the TBPE is proud to announce 459 examinees passed the PE exam and are now duly licensed professional engineers. In addition, 1,421 examinees passed the FE exam. Congratulations to all.
