

Policy Advisory Request – Engineering Procurement

Call for Technical Experts

The Texas Board of Professional Engineers is seeking experts as it forms a work group to study procurement as it relates to the practice of engineering and the provisions of the Texas Engineering Practice Act and Board rules. Specific issues of interest include:

- Alternative delivery methods for vertical and horizontal design and construction projects; such as, but not limited to: Design-Build; Construction Manager and Project Manager (CMPPM); Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC); and Construction Management At Risk (CMAR).
- Non-engineering companies contracting with clients for engineering services as part of the procurement process.
- The requirements for an alternative delivery contract and submitting a proposal for a project versus entering into a contract for a project.
