The Texas Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors (TBPELS) is seeking qualifications for up to 3 Registered Professional Land Surveyors (RPLS) to perform technical reviews and analysis of the compliance of surveys and surveying work products with the Professional Land Surveying Practices Act and Board rules. Activities include review and technical input on cases related to the practice of surveying in Texas, such as real property boundaries, platting and laying out land and subdivisions of land, preparing maps, record plats, field note records, easements and real property descriptions, as well as analyzing RPLS applications or Surveyor-In-Training (SIT) applications.

TBPELS will contract with the selected RPLS on a one-year basis to perform advanced review and analysis within a given scope and provide a written report as needed for cases and applications. A conflict of interest statement is required for each case.
